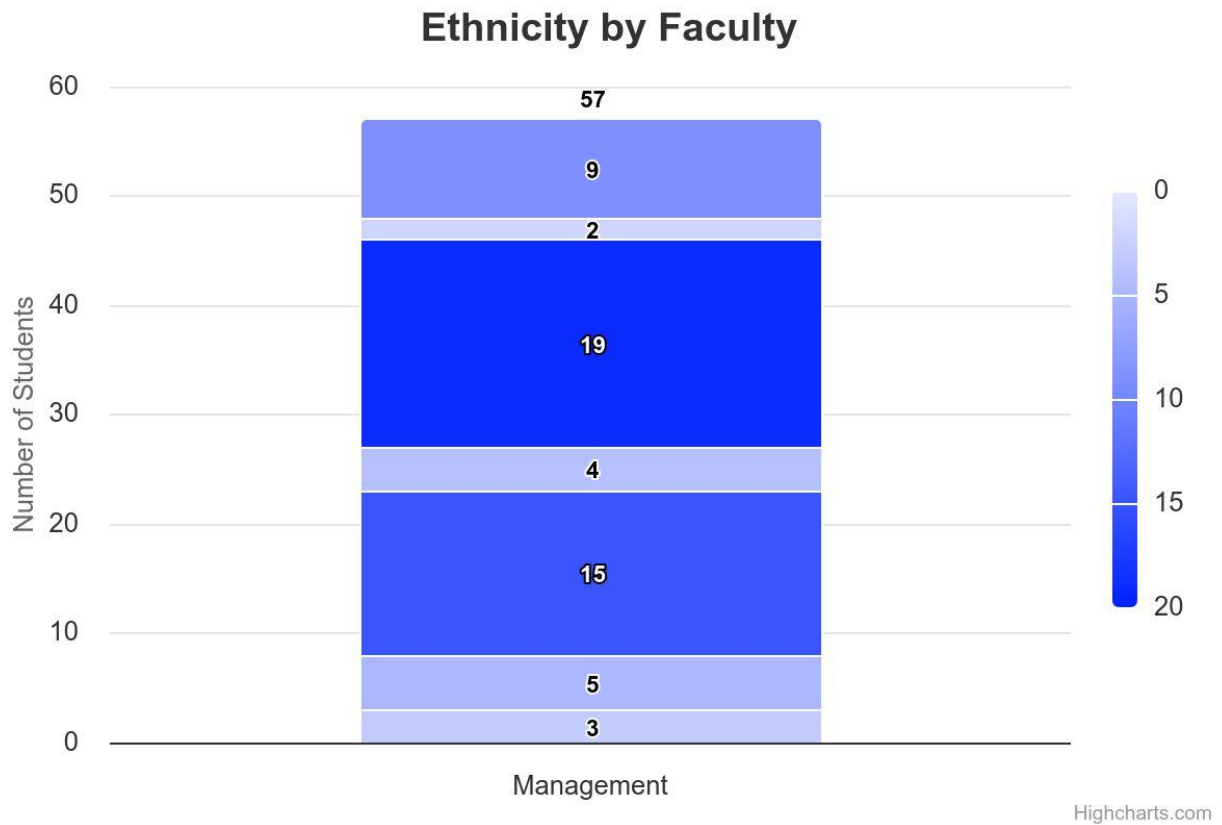

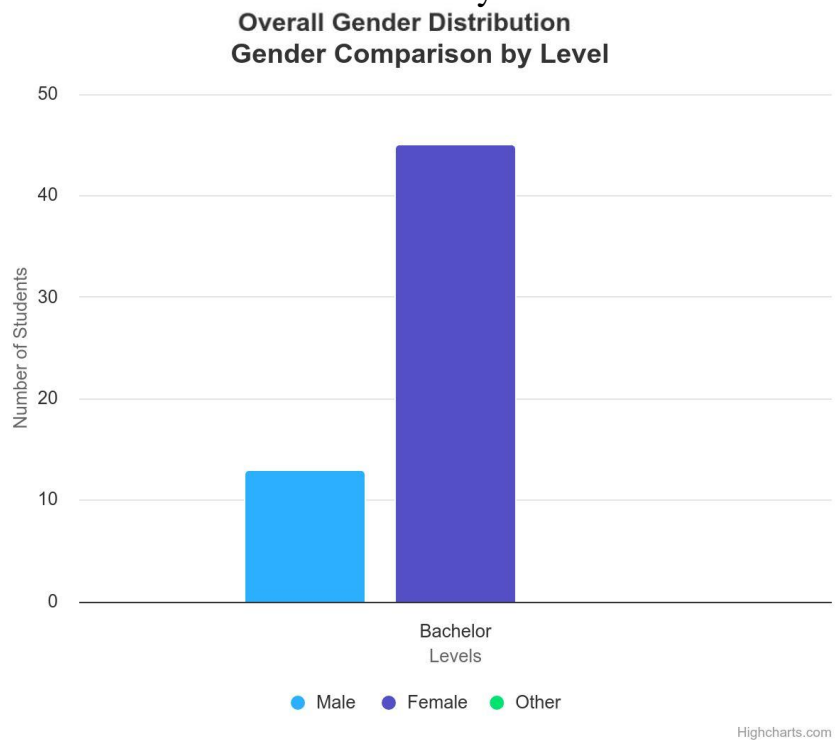
Management faculty accounts for 62% of enrollment with an almost balanced gender distribution.
